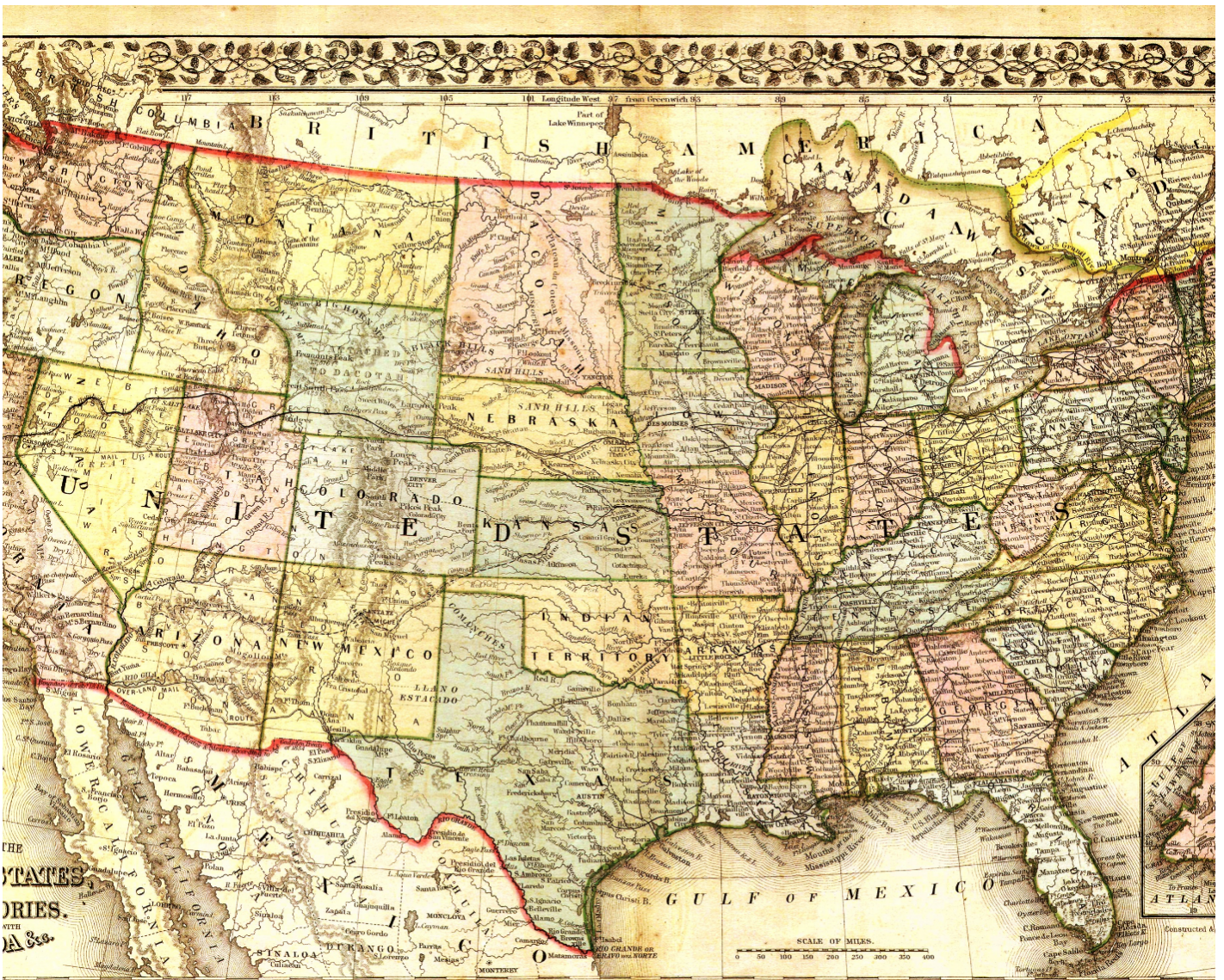

1. When you are going to purchase any type of plant always make sure that the variety, whether or not they are hybrids or grafted, are listed on the pot or package that it comes in.





2. Next, make sure that the plant you might purchase is suitable or adapted to the climate you live in.





3. Once you have completed step 1 and 2, you then can check the the plant you want for any signs of disease, pests or other signs of abnormalities.





4. Once you have followed all of the above and you are certain that the plant you want to buy is in top condition, you can then proceed to buy your plant. If you have further questions, be sure to ask the people or person that works in the gardening department.
